
### **B&NES BCF Planning 2025-2026**

- Move from 2-year plan to 1 year for 25-26 with a view to funding review in line with:
  - NHS 10-year plan
  - Emerging policy on social care reform
- Final planning expectation and metrics awaited. Expected metric changes to core metrics with supporting indicators:
  - Emergency admissions to hospital for 65+
    - Unplanned hospital admissions for ambulatory care sensitive conditions
    - Emergency admissions due to falls in 65+
  - Average length of discharge delay
    - Patients not discharged on discharge ready day and discharged on day 1, day 2-3, day 4-6, day 7-13 etc
    - Local average length of delay by pathway data
  - Residential admissions
- Consolidation of ring-fenced Local Authority Additional Discharge Funding into newly named Better Care Grant (although still required to be planned to enhance urgent care and flow) and ICB Additional Discharge Funding into NHS Minimum contribution
