**Transport Proposal: Parking Reinvestment Fund (one year only)**

**Council notes that this action would:- As stated in the Council budget papers**

- Delay investment improvements of car parks with Midsomer Norton & Radstock.
- Vulnerable people such as older, younger, disabled, pregnant people may be of increased harm if car parks are not well maintained.
- Improvements to street lighting and CCTV coverage across car parks may be delayed resulting in night time security risks for those who feel or are more vulnerable.
- Wider implications for the economy as people may choose to go elsewhere

**Council resolves to**

Reinstate the Parking Reinvestment Fund into the 25/26 budget, value £210k the funds to be reinvested from the increased parking revenue budget.
